

### Campaign Goal Announced


Our 2013 Annual Fund Campaign goal has been set at \$125,000. Every donation received in this campaign will go towards building a healthier Buffalo County, and will be used to serve Buffalo County residents as part of the Buffalo County 2020 Vision.

These donations have allowed us to be eligible for and receive significant amounts of grant funding. Each donation made to Community Partners is matched by \$6 in grant funding, and that number continues to grow. Because of this, donors are able to leverage significant change in our community. Every \$1 donated is matched by **\$6** in grant funding.

Less than **10%** of our annual budget is administrative cost.

**100%** of donations pledged in this campaign will serve Buffalo County residents in fulfillment of our mission.
