



## **Childcare Start Up Stipend Checklist**

The Childcare Start Up Stipend is funded by CRRSA and C4K. These funds are specifically designated to increase enrollment capacity in Buffalo County. Allocation of funds is a one-time stipend for newly licensed Family Child Care Homes I, Family Child Care Homes II, and Child Care Centers serving children ages birth to 5-years. These funds are allowable to be used toward operation of applicants newly licensed childcare program. This program may be disbanded if funding should be discontinued or materially reduced.
